| 2) Antonia was looking through old photo albums. The first had 635 pics and the second had 408. To the nearest hundred, how many pictures were there total? | $600 + 400$ 1000 | $635 + 408$ $1043 = 1000$ | 2. <u>1.000</u> |
| 3) An apple orchard was split into two sections. The first had 971 trees and the second had 947. To the nearest ten, how many trees were there total in the orchard? | $970 + 950$ 1920 | $971 + 947$ $1918 = 1920$ | 3. <u>1.920</u> |
| 4) A chef was buying different soups. She bought 948 cans of chicken soup and 288 cans of mushroom soup. To the nearest ten, how many can of soup did she buy all together? | $950 + 290$ 1240 | $948 + 288$ $1236 = 1240$ | 4. <u>1.240</u> |
| 5) A cookie company held a poll asking customers their favorite type of cookie. 421 people said chocolate chip and 984 said oatmeal. To the nearest hundred, what is the combined number of votes for both cookies? | $400 + 1000$ 1400 | $421 + 984$ $1405 = 1400$ | 5. <u>1.400</u> |
| 6) For lunch, 382 students selected chocolate milk and 895 selected regular milk. To the nearest ten, how many milks were taken total? | $380 + 900$ 1280 | $382 + 895$ $1277 = 1280$ | 6. <u>1.280</u> |
| 7) At the bank, a customer turned in 526 dimes and 349 nickels. To the nearest ten, what is the total number of coins the customer turned in? | $530 + 350$ 880 | $526 + 349$ $875 = 880$ | 7. <u>880</u> |
| 8) Emma was downloading apps to her phone. The first app she downloaded was 181 kb and the second was 132 kb. To the nearest hundred, what was the total size (in kb) of all the apps she downloaded? | $200 + 100$ 300 | $181 + 132$ $313 = 300$ | 8. <u>300</u> |
| 9) In one year a photographer took 634 pictures of animals and 579 pictures of people. To the nearest hundred, how many pictures did he take total? | $600 + 600$ 1200 | $579 + 634$ $1213 = 1200$ | 9. <u>1.200</u> |
| 10) The classes in the fourth grade were counting the fundraiser money they earned. Mr. Smith's Class earned 124 dollars and Mrs. White's class earned 858 dollars. To the nearest hundred, how much did they earn total? | $100 + 900$ 1000 | $124 + 858$ $982 = 1000$ | 10. <u>1.000</u> |
